Witango 5.0 goes into Public Beta

With Enterprise Pty Ltd today announced that the beta version of its much anticipated Witango 5.0 for Windows and Mac OS X would begin its public beta. This program follows an extensive and successful private beta program.

Downloading the software will constitute a 'sneak peak' at the new version of this sophisticated web application development suite, as well as an opportunity to provide important feedback to the company's development team ahead of the official launch scheduled for September.

Version 5 of the software incorporates several new features designed to make the software even more powerful and easy to use including:

- integration to POP3 and IMAP4
- improved pre-emptive multi-tasking
- improved debugging with improved error reporting, error trapping and full meta stack trace
- open interface to Witango Server (WISP)
- Customisation of Snippets
- Searching of Snippets (Windows Only)
- Additional views in the Development Studio (Windows Only)
- and a multitude of small improvements aimed at making your development even more productive.

With Enterprise is continuing the development of the Linux and Solaris versions of the Witango Application Server and expect to launch them before the end of the year. Our Sydney based team also continue to work on satellite projects like the WISP interface for JAVA and C++ which effectively opens the Application Server to front end applications like SOAP servers or non web based clients.

Internal testing of the Witango Compiler for J2EE is nearly complete - with performance and ease-of-use exceeding our expectations. With Enterprise anticipate the Compiler will be on the market within 4-6 months.
